## **GENERAL WARNING AND SAFETY INFORMATION**

## !!! Burning charcoal gives off carbon monoxide, which has no odor and can cause death. !!!

- Never leave stove unattended while in use or still hot after the use
- Stove is HOT while in use and will remain HOT for a period of time afterwards. Do not touch any part of the stove without wearing protective gloves
- Inside basket is cast iron, so It keeps HOT for a long time after use. It takes more than two hours to cool down after use.
- Avoid using damp/wet charcoal as it produce more smoke.
- · Never leave HOT coals or ashes unattended.
- Use only in very well ventilated areas. Never use inside an enclosed area such as a patio, garage, building, vehicle or tent. (READ CARBON MONOXIDE HAZARD).
- Keep area clear of all combustible materials such as wood, dry plants, grass, brush, paper or canvas.
- Keep a fire extinguisher accessible at all times while operating stove.
- Never operate this stove within 25 feet of flammable liquids. Never operate this stove within 10 feet of a gas cylinder.
- Never use this stove as a heater (READ CARBON MONOXIDE HAZARD).
- Use this stove only on a stable, level surface to prevent tipping.
- Use on non-combustible surfaces. Never use it directly on wood or any other flammable surfaces.
- Keep children and pets away from stove at all times. Do not allow children to use stove.
- Never move stove when in use. Allow stove to cool completely before moving or storing.
- Do not store stove with HOT ashes or charcoal inside stove. Store only when fire is completely out and all surfaces are cold. Dispose of cold ashes by placing them in aluminum foil, soaking with water and discarding in a non-combustible container.
- Never use this product for anything other than its intended purpose. The purpose is to heat water. Use only kettle or pot made to be used on open fire. Be careful when removing pot from stove. All surfaces are HOT and may cause burns. That also apply to the boiling water in the pot.
- Always use this stove in accordance with all applicable local, state and federal fire codes.

## STOVE OPERATION CAUTIONS

- · Avoid bumping or impacting stove.
- Inside basket is made from cast iron, it can crack do to impact or if it is dropped.
- Inside basket is cast iron, its veight is 5 pounds, so have that in mind, when operating with it.
- Outside is made from ceramics. It is fragile and it can be chipped or broken, when misused or not handle carefully
- We provide 2 year warranty, if the outside ceramic layer crack due to fire in basket.
- Keep your hands, hair and face away from burning charcoal. This stove has an open flame. Be careful of loose hair and clothing during operation. They may catch fire.
- Use protective gloves when handling this stove or working with fire. Use protective gloves or fireplace tools when adding wood or charcoal.
- Do not allow anyone to conduct activities around this stove during or following its use until the unit has cooled. This stove is HOT during operation and remains HOT for a period of time following its use.
- The use of alcohol, prescription or non- prescription drugs may impair the user's ability to properly assemble or safely operate this stove.
- Do not remove ash basket while ashes and charcoal are HOT.
- Never overfill charcoal grate. This can cause serious injury as well as damage the stove.
